Electra Theodorides-Bustle was appointed by Florida's Governor and Cabinet as the Executive Director of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles on February 27, 2007.

This 4500 employee department is one of the nation's largest safety and consumer oriented agencies which include the Florida Highway Patrol, the Division of Driver Licenses and the Division of Motor Vehicles.

Ms. Bustle has a diverse career which spans over 18 years and includes both private and public sector work with most of her career centering on government and law enforcement including Deputy General Counsel for the Florida Sheriffs Association; Assistant General Counsel for the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; General Counsel, Captain and Major for the Sarasota County Sheriff's Office. Prior to her appointment as Executive Director she served as an Assistant Commissioner with the Florida Department of Law Enforcement.
