

DHSMV's Office of Inspector General Invites Public Comment on Re-Accreditation

On July 17, a team of assessors from the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA) will be on-site at DHSMV to examine all aspects of the Department's Office of Inspector General (OIG) to ascertain continued compliance with the approximately 40 standards needed to maintain accredited status. These standards include the OIG's policies and procedures, management, operations and support services. Accreditation is part of a voluntary process every three years and recognizes professional excellence in the field

The assessment team is composed of law enforcement practitioners from similar agencies. The assessment team will review written materials; interview individuals; and visit offices and other places where compliance can be witnessed.
