MOBILE OFFICE BRINGS MOTORIST SERVICES TO HEALTH FAIR SATURDAY

MIAMI - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is pleased to announce that its Florida Licensing On Wheels (FLOW) mobile office will bring motorist services directly to those who attend the *Back to School Miami-Dade College North Campus Health Fair*. The event will provide information and basic preventative medical services, such as blood and cholesterol screenings, to those who attend.

The college will host the fair Aug. 15, 2009, at its North Campus located at 11380 NW 27th Ave., Miami, FL 33167. The hours of operation will be from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

FLOW mobiles are equipped with the technology and ability to bring valuable motorist services directly to customers. They provide a convenient method to renew a driver license, obtain a duplicate driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an identification card, renew a vehicle registration and purchase a specialty license plate. The mobile office also offers the Department's critical safety initiatives such as Emergency Contact Information registration, organ donor information and ID cards for children (ages five and older.)

With students heading back to school, now is a great time to register your Emergency Contact Information system. The Department created ECI nearly three years ago to allow Floridians to voluntarily register their emergency contact information either online or in an office using their Florida driver license or ID card number. The information can then be accessed only by law enforcement officers to find designated contacts in the case of an emergency.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or ID card must bring a certified copy of their birth certificate or a passport, proof of their Social Security number, and proof of residential address. The Department provides a complete list of acceptable documents online at www.flhsmv.gov/ddl/address.html. In addition to cash and personal checks, the Department accepts the following credit cards: MasterCard, American Express and Discover.
