West Palm Beach - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is pleased to announce that its Florida Licensing On Wheels (*FLOWmobile*) will participate in *Project Connect* on Nov. 20 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The event will be held at the Salvation Army Church, 2122 Palm Beach Lakes Blvd. in West Palm Beach. The Department is pleased to partner with event sponsor, the Homeless Coalition of Palm Beach County, Inc. Friday's event brings together resources for the homeless and persons at risk of becoming homeless. The coalition will cover costs for identification cards for the homeless.

FLOWmobiles are equipped with the technology and ability to bring valuable motorist services directly to customers. They provide a convenient method to renew a driver license, obtain a duplicate driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an ID card, register a vehicle and purchase a specialty license plate.

FLOWmobiles also offer the Department's newest safety initiatives through Emergency Contact Information registration, ID cards for children (ages five and older) and safety campaigns by the Florida Highway Patrol.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or ID card must bring an original or certified copy of their birth certificate, proof of their Social Security number and residential address. *FLOWmobile* staff will assist customers who do not have the required documents on hand by explaining what documents they need and how to obtain them.
