MOBILE OFFICE TO BRING MOTORIST SERVICES TO GAINESVILLE SUNDAY

~ Florida Licensing On Wheels delivers services and promotes safety ~

GAINESVILLE – The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is pleased to partner with Partnership for Strong Families and the Trinity United Methodist Church to bring motorist services to the public, saving a trip to our offices.

The Florida Licensing On Wheels (*FLOWmobile*) will be at the Fourth Annual National Family Week - Family Fun Day in the Trinity United Methodist Church parking lot at 4000 NW 53rd Ave. on Nov. 22. The hours of operation will be between 2 - 5 p.m.

Partnership for Strong Families is a Community Based Care organization that provides child welfare services in Alachua and nearby counties. The non-profit organization seeks to prevent child abuse and neglect, to place foster children in safe and healthy long-term family settings, and to keep youth from becoming runaways and from substance abuse.

FLOWmobiles are equipped with the technology and ability to bring valuable motorist services directly to customers. They provide a convenient method to renew a driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an identification card, register a vehicle and purchase a specialty license plate. *FLOWmobiles* also offer the Department's newest safety initiatives through Emergency Contact Information registration, ID cards for children (ages five and older) and safety campaigns by the Florida Highway Patrol.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or ID card must bring an original or certified copy of their birth certificate or a U.S. passport, as well as proof of their Social Security number and residential address. *FLOWmobile* staff will assist customers who do not have the required documents on hand by explaining what documents they need and how to obtain them. In addition to cash and personal checks, the Department accepts the following credit cards: MasterCard, American Express and Discover Card.
