## Traffic Signals

**Red** = Come to a complete stop.



**Yellow** = Stop if you can.



**Green** = Go!



### ALSO:

- ◆ **Flashing Red Light** = Stop!
- ◆ **Flashing Yellow Light** = Move forward with caution.
- ◆ **Non-Operating Signals** = Treat as a four way stop.

## Signs

Travel along any Florida highway and you will see a wide variety of road signs. In addition to the posted message, every sign's color tells you something about what's ahead.



**Yellow = General Warning Signs**  
Unexpected Conditions

**Red = Stop!**  
Do not enter or wrong way



**Blue = Motorist Services**  
or Guidance

**White = Regulatory Signs**  
Traffic Laws



**Orange = Construction**  
or Maintenance Warning


**Brown = Public Recreation Areas**  
and Scenic Guidance

## Pavement Markings





### Yellow Lane Lines

Used to separate traffic moving in opposite directions

### White Lane Lines

Used to separate traffic moving in the same direction




### Solid Yellow Lines

Used to prohibit vehicles from crossing the line

### Broken Yellow Lines


Motorist can pass with caution



## Markings


### Solid White Lines

Used to prohibit vehicles from changing lanes




### Broken White Line

Used to separate two lanes travelling in the same direction. Change lanes with caution.



### Double Solid White Lines

Used to separate two lanes of traffic going in the same direction. Crossing is prohibited.



**Use of directional signals prior to and while you are changing lanes is required by law!**
