DAVE evolved from an earlier system, Driver And Vehicle Information Database (DAVID), which has proven to be a valuable law enforcement tool. DAVE is a multifaceted database that affords immediate retrieval of driver information. The main difference between DAVE and DAVID is the absence of driver photos and signatures on DAVE. DAVE will still provide accurate, concise, and up-to-date information that is indispensable. DAVE incorporates various search platforms to instantaneously provide pertinent information at one easy-to-navigate website.

Information Search

Since all the search platforms are linked, one can access a great deal of information with just one piece of the puzzle.

Driver License

From the Main Response Screen and Driver License Application Screen, one can find out the status of a particular driver and any conditional messages attached to the driver license. In addition, one has access to a plethora of historical data, including when the license was renewed, restrictions, endorsements, and designations such as career criminal or sexual predator.

Driving Record

A condensed driver's record is provided for your use.

Vehicle Information

DAVE provides title and registration data on all vehicles owned and/or registered to a driver or a business. This data includes the vehicle description, the owner and registrant, lien details, and the latest insurance information as provided by the insurance carrier. It is also possible to research title and registration activity occurring after October 1999. This provides the ability to identify the previous owners and registrants of a vehicle, the various plates issued to a vehicle, and all the vehicles ever associated with a particular license plate.

Obtaining a DAVE Agreement

Government Agencies must have a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Department of Highway Safety to gain access to the information contained in DAVE.
