SUBJECT: **New Commercial Driver License/Privilege Disqualification Form,
HSMV 78005, Revised 7/2009**

Enclosed is the newly revised CDL Disqualification Form, **Revised 7/2009**. Please disregard any CDL Disqualification Forms utilized prior to the 7/2009 version. Changes have been made to include language authorizing the Department to administratively disqualify the commercial driving privilege of a CDL holder who is stopped under 316.193, F.S., and who refuses to submit to a breath, urine, or blood test – regardless of whether the person was operating a CMV or personal vehicle at the time of the stop.

The *paper* Florida DUI citation, Rev. 2/05 or 7/06, may still be utilized until new DUI citations are printed. **Effective immediately, officers issuing paper Florida DUI citations to CDL holders must also issue the CDL disqualification form, Revised 7/2009.**

The *electronic* Florida DUI Uniform Traffic Citation (UTC) must be revised to include the appropriate notice regarding the CDL disqualification. Please have your electronic DUI citation vendor contact our office for details. Until your electronic DUI citation is revised, please issue the attached CDL disqualification form. Once the electronic DUI citation is revised, the form will no longer be necessary, as the appropriate notice will be included on the electronic citation.
