

SUBJECT: Changes to the Certified Driver Record as per
Section 322.201, Florida Statutes

In an effort to save tax payer dollars and processing costs, we will discontinue using our imprinted, raised seal to certify driver license documents such as DAVID print-outs of photos, signatures, driver license applications, and address files effective October 1, 2009. A recent change to s. 322.201, Florida Statutes, no longer requires court documents to have the "machine imprint" to be used as evidence in court proceedings. We will stamp these documents as "certified" with my signature.

We will continue to use the raised seal on all certified Florida driver transcripts for your convenience.
