SUBJECT: Temporary Permits

The Department issues temporary driving permits to individuals whose driver licenses may be expired, revoked, or suspended. These temporary driving permits allow the holder to legally drive in Florida through the expiration date of the temporary permit and are specifically authorized by Florida law.

In these cases, the driver license status on the Individual Summary Page in DAVID will display as **EXPIRED, REVOKED, SUSPENDED, or CANCELLED** with **CLASS E TEMPORARY PERMIT UNTIL: XX/XX/XXXX** or similar language displayed in the Conditional Messages area under the driver's photo.

Please note that these individuals are legally permitted to drive and should not be cited for driving while license suspended, cancelled, or revoked.

On November 7, 2007, we distributed a memorandum to law enforcement announcing that temporary permits now display in DAVID under the driver's photo. This memorandum is posted on the DAVID Message Center.
