

SUBJECT: Driver License Requirements for Law Enforcement Officers

Florida law requires that an applicant for an original, renewal, or replacement driver license or identification card present a certified copy of his or her birth certificate or a valid U.S. passport; proof of social security number; and two proofs of residential address. For a customized list of acceptable documents, please visit www.GatherGoGet.com.

Florida law also requires that driver licenses and ID cards show the customer's residential address. Mailing addresses, including Post Office Boxes, are no longer printed on the driver license or ID card.

However, law enforcement officers applying for a driver license or identification card are exempt from the requirement that the residential address appear on the face of the license or ID card. To ensure your mailing address prints on the card:

- You need to do nothing if your driver record already has a Law Enforcement Block. The card will automatically print with the mailing address.
- If your driver record is not blocked, please complete the Law Enforcement Block form at www.flhsmv.gov/courts and mail it to the address listed in the instructions. The form is on the right side of the page under 'Law Enforcement Agency Information.'
- Alternatively, you may present law enforcement credentials or documentation of eligibility on your agency's letterhead to the examiner at the driver license office.

If your agency allows it, you may use your work address as your mailing address.
