SUBJECT: Repeal of F.S. 316.2024, Coasting Downhill Prohibited

Please be advised that this memo is to officially inform all Law Enforcement Agencies that, effective April 27, 2011, section 316.2024, Florida Statutes, has been repealed.

Section 316.2024 of the Florida Statutes state ‘The driver of any motor vehicle, when traveling upon a downgrade, shall not coast with the gears or transmission of such vehicle in neutral or the clutch disengaged.’

As a result of the repeal this law will no longer appear in Appendix C as a punishable traffic violation.
