RE: **Section 318.14 F.S., Noncriminal traffic infractions; exceptions; procedures**

The 2005 Legislature amended Section 318.14(9) and 318.14(10), Florida Statutes, to prohibit commercial driver license holders from making an election. Many Clerks of Court are still allowing commercial driver license drivers this option in addition to non-CDL drivers who are no longer eligible.

The department has developed four reports that identify ineligible elections submitted to the Department. These reports are 1) CDL drivers who elected school, 2) CDL drivers who elected proof of compliance, 3) Non-CDL who elected school and 4) Non-CDL who elected proof of compliance. These reports are labeled on the attached form(s) on the top and bottom of the left side of the report as described in the table below.

CDL drivers who elected proof of compliance	PDBS510B	318.14(10)

Each citation will require a supplemental disposition to be sent through the Traffic Citation Accounting and Transmission System (TCATS) to the department.
