

## Electronic UTC Summary

The table below depicts the progress of the electronic Uniform Traffic Citation (UTC) use by law enforcement in the state. The data indicates law enforcement agencies (LEAs) are increasingly using computer generated citations created by mobile laptops or hand held devices. Today, 54.6% of law enforcement agencies are using or preparing to use e-citations; this percentage has increased exponentially as the total number of LEAs using e-citations has increased while the total number of LEAs in Florida has decreased. Currently, there are 16 approved vendors for the state which produce e-citations; this is double the number of approved vendors serving law enforcement in September of 2006. Currently, Florida Highway Patrol can transmit electronic UTC data through Florida Association of Court Clerks to more than 40 County Clerks of Courts.
