

Subject: DHSMV New Traffic Crash Report Electronic Submission

For law enforcement agencies interested in submitting traffic crash reports electronically to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles --

As you are aware, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will be implementing a new traffic crash report form effective January 1, 2011. The new traffic crash report form will be designated as form number HSMV 90010S. There are two layout versions of the new traffic crash report form, one for traffic crash reports mailed to the Department and one for reports submitted electronically.

The layout for reports mailed is attachment PrintedHSMV90010S.zip. The zip file has three pdfs. The sequence for the mailed report is Event.pdf, VehiclePerson.pdf, Narrative.pdf. This form will be mandatory effective January 1, 2011 for all agencies mailing crash reports to the Department and will not be accepted before that date. The Department will supply printed versions of this report for those requesting such.

Electronic submission to the Department will be by ftp and traffic crash reports will be in an XML format. The specifications for the electronically submitted HSMV Traffic Crash Report Form (HSMV 90010S) is as follows (see attachments):

- XMLSchemaDefinition2010v2.03.zip, which contains the xsd files that make up the XML schema. CrashEvent.xsd is the root; all others are referenced as includes, either directly or indirectly.
- ElectronicHSMV90010S.pdf – A sample PDF version of a computer generated crash report form (Electronic version of HSMV-90010S). The data submitted electronically will be regenerated for print and sales in this layout by DHSMV. It is expected that agencies submitting to the Department electronically, and creating printed reports for their own use, will follow the sequence of elements and fields as close as possible, font style and size are unrestricted and printed reports need only show what is applicable for that crash. (Note: fields with values in the sample pdf are merely for illustration and by no means represent any true crash report or crash scenario). Attachment EcrashPersonVariations.pdf demonstrates different print possibilities depending on the type of Person involved (Driver, NonMotorist, Passenger) --- and again is for illustration.
