### 1. LICENSE SUSPENSION

- a. When a person issued a Uniform Traffic Citation fails to pay their traffic fine, fails to appear in court, fails to attend a court ordered school or has taken an illegal election under 318.14, a notice to suspend the person's license should be transmitted through TCATS.
- b. Data is transmitted to DHSMV and spooled to tapes that are processed to the driver record three times a week.
- c. Orders are post dated 20 days from the mail date.
- d. The court can suspend the person's license for one or more reasons on the same citation. However, to reissue a suspension for a reason that has already been suspended, the prior suspension must be reinstated before transmitting the new suspension. Example: Records show ticket 1234AAA suspended for failure to pay. The person failed to make a payment. The person comes in to pay once they receive the suspension notice but the check bounces. The court wants to re-suspend. The first suspension must be fully reinstated with a reinstatement date appearing. Then transmit the new suspension for failure to pay. This must be sent with "re-issue flag" (field 22 in the ICD for D6).

### 2. D6 Error Edits

D6 suspension data is processed through edit checks at DHSMV for the following reasons.

### 3. **REINSTATEMENT OF D6 SUSPENSION THROUGH TCATS**

a. When a person has satisfied the requirements for an infraction, a clearance or a reinstatement can be transmitted through TCATS.

- (1) Clearance – Citation paid after date of suspension. Court has not collected reinstatement fee of up to \$47.50. A code of “34” (field 15 in the ICD for D6) is transmitted through TCATS to indicate “Court Requirements Met” Restore date should be “zero”.
- (2) Reinstatement – Court has collected the reinstatement fee of up to \$47.50 or person has satisfied the court requirement prior to the suspension date. Restore date should be transmitted (field 10 in the ICD for D6).

**NOTE:** Because D6 reinstatements are only processed 3 times a week, we encourage courts to collect all required fees and reinstate the person online through DRC1. (See Section 11). In the event your court does not reinstate through DRC1, we encourage you to give the person a clearance. Processing through TCATS will delay the reinstatement of the person’s driving privilege.

### 4. OUT-OF-STATE DRIVERS

- a. When a suspension notice or a reinstatement notice is transmitted to DHSMV through TCATS, a computer generated form is produced and mailed to other state.
- b. Suspensions for out-of-state violators should be transmitted to DHSMV timely. Other states are not required to process suspension if the offense date is over six months old.

### 5. OUT OF COUNTRY

The state of Florida only has an agreement with Canada to mail dispositions and D6 suspension notices. If other countries are transmitted to DHSMV they are just dropped. No data is retained.

6. D6 suspensions on companies are not processed. No data is retained. We only suspended driving privilege of individuals.
