

Subject: House Bill 393, all models manufactured by a recreational vehicle manufacturer will be specified as a line-make

The Florida Legislature passed House Bill 393 amending section 320.771(1)(a)(2), Florida Statutes, to read:

“A dealer may apply for a certificate of title to a recreational vehicle required to be registered under s. 320.08(9), using a manufacturer’s statement of origin as permitted by s. 319.23(1), only if such dealer is authorized by a manufacturer/dealer agreement, as defined in s. 320.3202, on file with the Department, to buy, sell, or deal in that particular line-make of recreational vehicle, and the dealer is authorized by such agreement to perform delivery and preparation obligations and warranty defect adjustments on that line-make.”

This will become effective July 1, 2012.

Pursuant to the above all models manufactured by a recreational vehicle manufacturer will be specified as a line-make.

Due to the legislative changes, the Division of Motorist Services, Bureau of Issuance Oversight, has contacted the 127 licensed recreational vehicle manufacturers and requested a copy of their dealer sales and service agreements with their authorized dealers listing the line-make(s) each dealer is authorized to sell. These line-makes will be added to the line-make code table in the Florida Real Time Vehicle Information System (FRVIS). The dealer license records for all licensed recreational vehicle dealers in Florida that sell new recreational vehicles will also be updated in FRVIS to reflect the correct line-makes.

The list of licensed recreational vehicle manufacturers and dealers with their license numbers and assigned line-makes will be updated in FRVIS. Please refer to this list when you process the title work for new recreational vehicles beginning July 1, 2012.
