

Monthly, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles creates reports showing pending or suspended transactions in the electronic filing system (EFS) that are over 30 days. Pursuant to section 319.23(6), Florida Statutes, dealers are required to complete transactions within 30 days. The Department has noticed that the number of outstanding transactions has increased recently.

With oversight of EFS transferring to the state, the Department will be enforcing these provisions to ensure that transactions are completed. We encourage you to complete any pending transactions to ensure your compliance with law. Pursuant to Rule 15C-18.007(1), Florida Administrative Code, the Department is requesting that the Certified Service Providers work with their EFS dealers and agents and the respective Tax Collectors to correct these errors.
