Williamson has come by and checked on me and made sure he has taken care of all paper work for me. On his days off he has called to check on me. Like Captain Karasek, Sgt. Williamson has made it easy for me to just work on getting better.

Mike also has called or came by everyday to check on me. When I first got out of the hospital, I would get out of bed, Mike would be out washing my personal vehicle in my drive-way. He would attempt to cut my lawn but I would have to put my foot down.
