Prior to my being transported to Jackson County Hospital, Chris moved my car to a more convenient location, located my overnight bag, locked the car and made arrangements with the station manager to keep an eye on the car. It meant a great deal to me to have someone extend comfort and reassurance at such a distressing time.

Several hours later, Patrolman McAdams visited me in the emergency room to reassure me once again that all was safe and to offer his assistance should I need a ride back to my car. My family joins me in thanking him for his kindness, which I believe went above and beyond the call of duty.
