
On behalf of the officers and staff of the Rockledge Police Department, I would like to express our sincere appreciation to the Florida Highway Patrol and you for your active participation in our first Car Seat Inspection. I would especially like to thank you for the expertise that you brought to the event. As you know, we are relatively new to the child seat program. I assure you that we appreciate your contribution considerably. We were very pleased at the turnout from within our community. I have been in law enforcement for many years and have never seen an event received with more enthusiasm from the community, law enforcement personnel and technicians alike.

I am pleased to inform you that with your help, we processed 35 vehicles, provided 24 new child restraints and identified numerous installation and/or compatibility issues in all but one vehicle. Several of the existing child seats were subject to recall and were replaced. The remaining problems were resolved and in instances where the children were present, they departed the checkpoint with improved safety.

We have scheduled additional child seat events for the second Tuesday of each month. The monthly event will be conducted at the Rockledge Police Department between the hours of 1 PM and 6 PM. The event will be by appointment only, thereby enabling us to have the appropriate personnel and equipment on hand.
