Dear Captain Duncan,

I would like to extend to you my appreciation for the assistance rendered by Corporal Lawrence Smith (ID #1052) during the recent arrest of Eugene Jenerette on November 2, 2002. Jenerette was arrested on S.R.417 near Lake Jessup after a monthlong investigation. Jenerette has been charged with Attempted First degree Pre-meditated Murder with a Firearm, Solicitation to Commit Murder, and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. These charges stem from a plot that had been hatched to murder Career Criminal Prosecutor Tom Hastings.

Corporal Smith, while on routine patrol in the vicinity, came upon undercover elements from the State Attorney Investigative Division and Seminole County Sheriff's Office conducting a Felony traffic stop. Corporal Smith responded and maintained a cover position while the felon was taken into custody.

Once the defendant was in custody Corporal Smith agreed without hesitation to assist in the transport of the undercover State Attorney Investigator to the Sheriff's Office in furtherance of the operation.

The enthusiasm, dedication and professionalism exhibited by Corporal Smith reflect greatly upon himself, his profession and the Florida Highway Patrol.
