It is with great pleasure that we write this letter regarding Florida Highway Patrol Trooper Giuliano.

About 1:30 PM on Friday, June 20, 2003, my wife and I, with another passenger, were returning to our home in Ft. Pierce, Fla. via I-10. About halfway between Quincy and Tallahassee, we suffered a mishap to our car - a ply separation to one of the tires resulting in disruption of the electrical circuitry to the rear of the car, including the fuel pump. This rendered the car inoperable.

A "good samariton" called a tow truck for us and shortly thereafter Trooper Giuliano arrived. We cannot commend too highly his assistance and attitude. He waited with us until the tow truck arrived. He provided transportation to the automobile dealer of our choice and made sure that we were accommodated properly, and offered further assistance if such should be necessary.
