The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, Division of Florida Highway Patrol has received the required report submitted by an independent testing laboratory fulfilling the approval requirements for light transmittance measuring devices to be used in the State of Florida, for the purpose of obtaining evidence of non-compliance of light transmittance tolerances.
