SUBJECT: Eustis Storm Damage Report

Weather officials confirm that a tornado touched down in Eustis, Florida around 9:30 p.m. on September 20, 2007. The tornado damaged approximately 50 site-built homes; 20 homes were seriously damaged and 30 homes have been deemed uninhabitable by authorities.

No mobile/manufactured homes were damaged or destroyed during the storm on Thursday night; only site-built homes. One RV was picked up and thrown several feet from the owners home. Other damage occurred when trees collapsed on top of cars, chimneys toppled to the ground and aluminum attachments flew everywhere. Please see attached pictures.
