*REGISTER YOUR EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION WEEK*

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' Emergency Contact Information program allows all individuals with a Florida driver license or identification card to voluntarily provide emergency contact information online at [www.flhsmv.gov/eci](http://www.flhsmv.gov/eci) or in a driver license office; and

WHEREAS, registering information in the state of Florida's award-winning ECI system is a highly effective way to enhance the lives of Floridians by providing contact information to law enforcement officers during critical emergencies; and

WHEREAS, more than 4.8 million Floridians have registered their Emergency Contact Information as of August 2011; and

WHEREAS, To Inform Families First (TIFF) was created by Christine Olson after losing her daughter, Tiffiany, in a fatal motorcycle crash in 2005 to ensure law enforcement officers have the information they need to notify loved ones when emergencies arise; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and TIFF have joined together to encourage all Florida licensed drivers and identification card holders to register or update their information, which is stored in a secure database used only by law enforcement agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rick Scott, Governor of the State of Florida, do hereby extend greetings and best wishes to all observing October 2 - 8, 2011 as *Register Your Emergency Contact Information Week*.
