## **LOCAL DRIVER LICENSE OFFICE IS MOVING TO EDGEWATER**

**NEW SMYRNA BEACH** - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is pleased to announce that its local office will have a new permanent address. At 5 p.m. tomorrow, the driver license office located at 1704 State Road 44 New Smyrna Beach, FL 32168, will close its doors. When the office re-opens for business, it will have a new address. The office will re-locate to 2986 South Ridgewood Ave., Edgewater, FL 32141, on March 8. Office hours will remain as 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday at the new location. All New Smyrna Beach Driver License office employees will be reassigned to the Edgewater office.

To receive uninterrupted driver services during the transition, customers may visit the following driver license offices in Volusia County:

When possible, the Department encourages customers to skip the trip and conduct their driver license business online at [www.flhsmv.gov](http://www.flhsmv.gov), where they can access various online services. Customers can renew their driver licenses, identification cards and vehicle tags, as well as change their address all from the comfort of their home or office. There are no surcharges for using the Internet. If a customer has received notification from the Department that he/she will have to come into an office, he/she can make an appointment at [www.flhsmv.gov/oasis](http://www.flhsmv.gov/oasis). The online appointment service is an excellent time saving tool.

Florida now requires additional documents to obtain a new or renewed driver license or ID card, so visit the website to be sure you have all the documents you need before you make the trip.
