## **TALLAHASSEE DRIVER LICENSE OFFICE TO CLOSE THIS MONTH**

*~ Leon County Tax Collector now provides expanded driver license services ~*

**TALLAHASSEE** - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles wants to advise the public of upcoming changes to our local driver license office.

The driver license issuance office located at 1450 504-A Capital Circle Southeast in Tallahassee will close March 31, 2009. The closest state office is located nearby in the Neil Kirkman Building at 2900 Apalachee Parkway. Customers who need to take a road test can only do so at the Leon County Tax Collector's office at 3477 S. Monroe St. in Tallahassee. Customers can schedule appointments for driver license services by logging on to [www.flhsmv.gov](http://www.flhsmv.gov).

Department employees from the Capital Circle office will relocate to the Neil Kirkman Building to continue offering select motorist services, such as issuing driver licenses and identification cards, record sales and motor vehicle tag and title work.

"The Department encourages customers to skip the trip and conduct their driver license business online at [www.flhsmv.gov](http://www.flhsmv.gov), where various online services are available," said Division of Driver Licenses Director Sandra Lambert. "Customers can renew their driver licenses, identifications cards and vehicle tags, and change their address on their license or ID card from the comfort of their own home. They also can make an appointment at <http://oasis.hsmv.state.fl.us>, which can save them time."
