## MOBILE OFFICE TO ISSUE DRIVER LICENSES AND MORE TO VETERANS

*~ Bringing services directly to you ~*

**JACKSONVILLE** – The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will be demonstrating our appreciation to Florida’s military veterans and servicemembers. As a “thank you” to our troops, past and present, the Department is pleased to announce its participation in an event this week to bring services directly to them, saving them a possible trip to our offices. On April 17, 2009, the Florida Licensing On Wheels mobile office will be at a veterans’ job fair in Jacksonville.

Florida Licensing On Wheels mobile units are equipped with the technology and ability to bring valuable DHSMV services directly to customers. They provide a convenient method to renew a driver license, obtain a duplicate driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an identification card, renew a vehicle registration and purchase a specialty license plate.

The FLOW mobile also offers the Department’s newest safety initiatives through Emergency Contact Information registration, identification cards for children (ages five and older) and safety campaigns by the Florida Highway Patrol.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or ID card must bring an original or certified copy of their birth certificate and proof of their Social Security Number. A complete list of acceptable identification documents is provided at [www.flhsmv.gov/ddl/faqkeys.html](http://www.flhsmv.gov/ddl/faqkeys.html). The Department reminds customers seeking a new or renewed Florida driver license or ID card to be prepared to provide proof of their residential address. A customer’s mailing address, such as a Post Office Box number, will no longer be shown on driver licenses and ID cards.
