FLORIDA LICENSING ON WHEELS TO SERVE CUSTOMERS AT RESOURCE FAIR

LAUDERHILL, Fla. – The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is pleased to announce that its Florida Licensing on Wheels mobile office will participate in the City of Lauderhill Community Resource Fair. The city of Lauderhill will host the fair in partnership with the Broward Re-Entry Coalition program. The event will provide ex-offenders and others in need with housing information, employment opportunities, health services, legal aid and much more.

FLOW mobile units are equipped with the technology and ability to bring valuable motorist services directly to customers. They are handicap accessible and provide a convenient method to renew a driver license, obtain a duplicate driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an identification card, renew a vehicle registration and purchase a specialty license plate.

The FLOW mobile also offers the Department's newest safety initiatives through Emergency Contact Information registration, identification cards for children (ages five and older) and safety campaigns by the Florida Highway Patrol.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or ID card must bring an original or certified copy of their birth certificate and proof of their Social Security number. DHSMV provides a complete list of acceptable identification documents at www.flhsmv.gov/ddl/faqkeys.html. Customers also need to bring proof of their residential address because driver licenses and ID cards no longer show non-residential addresses, such as a post office box number.

The cost of an ID card is \$10. Acceptable methods of payment include cash, check and select credit cards (MasterCard, American Express and Discover.)
