GREEN COVE SPRINGS DRIVER LICENSE OFFICE TO CLOSE THIS WEEK

~ Clay County Tax Collector now provides expanded driver license services ~

GREEN COVE SPRINGS, Fla. - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles wants to advise the public of an upcoming change to the local driver license office. The driver license office located at 4255 US 17 S, Green Cove Springs, FL 32043, will close June 3, 2009.

Employees from the office will continue to provide excellent customer service, but now under a new roof only three miles away. Beginning next week, they will offer motorist services under the purview of the Clay County Tax Collector. Examples of services include issuing driver licenses and identification cards, administering the road test, and fielding requests for records and motor vehicle tag and title work. The Clay County Tax Collector's office will begin to offer the motorist services at the office located at 477 Houston Street in Green Cove Springs on June 8, 2009.

"The Department encourages customers to skip the trip and conduct their driver license business online at www.GoRenew.com," said Division of Driver Licenses Director Sandra Lambert. "Customers can renew their driver licenses, identifications cards and vehicle tags, and change their address on their license or ID card from the comfort of their own home. They also can make an appointment at <http://oasis.hsmv.state.fl.us>, which can save them time."
