## **MOBILE OFFICE TO ISSUE DRIVER LICENSES, IDENTIFICATION CARDS AT CELEBRATION THIS WEEKEND**

*~ A great opportunity for parents and guardians to get identification cards for children ~*

**CALLAHAN** - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is pleased to announce that its Florida Licensing On Wheels mobile will be at the *20 Year Celebration of the Callahan Bus Depot* sponsored by the West Nassau County Historical Society on Nov. 15, 2008, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. The celebration will be held at 45383 Dixie Ave. in Callahan.

The Florida Licensing On Wheels mobile units are equipped with the technology and ability to bring valuable DHSMV services directly to customers. They provide a convenient method to renew a driver license, obtain a duplicate driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an identification card, register a vehicle and purchase a specialty license plate.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or identification card must bring an original or certified copy of their birth certificate and proof of their Social Security number. In addition to cash and personal checks, the Department accepts the following credit cards: MasterCard, American Express and Discover.

The Department encourages parents to obtain a state of Florida identification card for their children between the ages of five and 17. A child's identification card allows law enforcement immediate access to information on the child, including their picture which is critical during an emergency or an investigation. As an additional service, FLOW mobile staff will provide driver license and ID card holders the opportunity to enter Emergency Contact Information into a secure database accessible only by law enforcement.
