INVERNESS DRIVER LICENSE OFFICE TO CLOSE THIS MONTH

~ Services will continue to be offered to area drivers ~

INVERNESS - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles wants to advise the public of upcoming changes to your local driver license office.

The driver license office located at 1103 Inverness Blvd. in Inverness will close Dec. 26, 2008. The next closest office for customers is located at 1020 N.E. 5th St. in Crystal River.

Employees from the Inverness office will relocate to other driver license offices to continue offering excellent customer service.

The Honorable Janice Warren, Citrus County Tax Collector, will begin offering driver license services between mid-January and mid-February in the Inverness Tax Collector office. She is currently evaluating which services they will be able to offer at this location.

“The Department encourages customers to skip the trip and conduct their driver license business online at www.flhsmv.gov, where various online services are available. Customers can renew their driver licenses, identifications cards and vehicle tags, and change their address on their license or ID card from the comfort of their own home by using our online services,” said Division of Driver Licenses Director Sandra Lambert. “If a customer has received notification from the Department to come into an office, they can make an appointment at <http://oasis.hsmv.state.fl.us>. Making an appointment can be a time saving tool for customers.”
