## DRIVER LICENSE OFFICE ASKS CUSTOMERS TO PARDON OUR PROGRESS

*~ Haines City office to close next week; mobile office will provide motorist services ~*

**HAINES CITY, Fla.** - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles announces that the Driver License office, located at 930 Lily Avenue East in Haines City, will close for renovations next week on Dec. 7 - 11, 2009. The office will reopen Dec. 14 and will provide an improved environment for customers and employees.

Office staff will set up the Florida Licensing On Wheels (*FLOW*mobile) in the driver license office parking lot to assist customers while the actual building is closed. Customers also have the option to skip the trip and conduct their driver license business online at [www.GoRenew.com](http://www.GoRenew.com). Using the virtual office, gives customers a convenient way to get the motorist services they need in the comfort of their own home or at work.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or ID card must bring an original or certified copy of their birth certificate or a U.S. passport, as well as proof of their Social Security number and residential address. In addition to cash and personal checks, the Department accepts the following credit cards: MasterCard, American Express and Discover Card.

Planning to renew your license or ID card or to apply for a new one after the New Year? Be sure to plan ahead. Florida has new requirements for such credentials that take effect Jan. 1, 2010.
