SUBJECT: Deauthorization of Hispanic Achievers and St. Johns River Specialty License Plates and Presale License Plate Vouchers	

Overview:

The **Hispanic Achievers** (330 license plates sold, 48 vouchers) and **St. Johns River** (587 license plates sold, 52 vouchers) are being deauthorized. Both license plates failed to reach the combined active registration/voucher minimum of 1,000 within 24 months.

Details:

Customers who currently have a Hispanic Achievers or St. Johns River specialty license plate will be forced to replace it at their next renewal. They may select another specialty license plate or choose a regular license plate.

Included in the next FRVIS deployment, when replacing the license plate, the customer will receive an Advanced Replacement Fund (ARF) credit for any fees already paid towards the license plate annual replacement fee. If any customer is required to replace their plate prior to the FRVIS deployment they will receive a refund check from the department for the amount of the ARF credit.

Additionally, effective, July 1, 2016, presale vouchers for Hispanic Achievers and St. Johns River license plates were deauthorized in FRVIS and are no longer available to customers.

A customer who purchased either of these vouchers may request a refund, or apply their presale voucher as a credit towards any other specialty license plate. The customer will only receive a refund for the specialty license plate fee.
