1. Measure your vessel applying the guidelines depicted in the above diagram.
2. Record your Florida registration number along with the actual length of your vessel in the space provided in item #1 above.
3. Take this affidavit with your certificate of title and certificate of registration to any county tag agency.
4. Until corrections can be made and the original certificate returned to you, retain a photocopy of your certificate of registration on board your vessel as proof of current registration.
