At the opening of the Statement of Qualification and Services Offered for ITN 008-09, Legal Case Management System two vendors submitted proposals; Sustain Technologies, Inc. and Client Profiles Inc.

Both vendors were deemed non-responsive.

Sustain Technologies, Inc. was considered non-responsive due to the expense of their proposal. The price proposal for the first year of the contract; while meeting the requirement for the maximum allotted sum of \$80,000.00, failed to factor in the costs of the annual license fees. Additionally, the vendor indicated that there would be an undetermined cost to the Department for the issuance of a performance bond.

Client Profiles Inc. did not include signed addendum number one with their proposal and as a result were found to be non-responsive.
