Can we get the number of units broken down by age; all over 5 years, number from 2 to 5 years and the number less than 2 years in age?

Answer to Question # 2: Over 5 yrs – 1,488, 2 to 5 yrs – 230, Less than 2 yrs - 302

Question # 3 received from Williams Communications, Inc:

Can we get a summary of who the current contract is with and a unit price?

Answer to Question # 3: Currently the Florida Highway Patrol is contracting with Communications International, Inc. Our cost per Radar is \$7.50 a month and our cost per Laser is \$12.50 per month.

All other dates and terms and conditions remain the same in this Invitation to Bid.

## 1.0 PURPOSE AND GENERAL INFORMATION

**1.1 PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Invitation to Bid is to establish a three (3) year contract with the option to renew for an additional three (3) year term with any factory authorized service center for radars, and to calibrate lasers. Servicing dealer must provide all labor and parts for repairs and calibration services necessary on Florida Highway Patrol Radar units and to provide labor only for the calibration of Laser units. Exceptions for Radar unit repairs include cases of damage by vehicle crash, fire or water, misuse, abuse and accidental damage. There are approximately one thousand seven hundred and twenty (1720) radar units statewide, forty six (46) units will be motorcycle mounted, the rest automobile mounted. Vendor must also provide calibration services for an estimated three hundred and fifty four (354) Laser units located in the State of Florida. Only Contractors located in the State of Florida may submit a proposal.

**1.2 GLOSSARY:** See attached PUR 1000, Paragraph 1, and PUR 1001, Paragraph 1 for further definitions.

**Contractor:** The proposer who is awarded a contract by the Department as a result of this solicitation.

**Day:** A Calendar day.

**Department:** Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles

**Direct Order:** A Direct Order is a purchase order issued via the eProcurement system. See attached PUR Form 1000, paragraph 2.

**Equipment Failure:** A malfunction in equipment maintained by the contractor that delays or prevents the State's productive use of said equipment for the purpose for which said equipment was installed.

**FHP:** Florida Highway Patrol

**ITB:** Invitation to Bid

**Machine(s):** Equipment, components and/or their features, model conversions, equipment elements and accessories submitted by the contractor in response to this solicitation.

**Number of Verbs or Nouns:** Throughout this solicitation, the singular may be read as the plural and the plural as the singular.

**Packing:** Tangible product shall be securely and properly packed for shipment, storage, and stocking in appropriate, clearly labeled, shipping containers and according to accepted commercial practice, without extra charge for packing materials, cases or other types of containers. All containers and packing shall become and remain Department property.

**Proposer:** Any firm or person who submits a proposal to the Department in response to this solicitation.

**Proposal:** All information and materials submitted by a proposer in response to this solicitation.

**State:** State shall be synonymous with the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

**Subcontractor:** Any person other than an employee of the contractor who performs any of the services listed in this solicitation for compensation paid by the contractor.

**Vendor:** Any firm or person who submits a proposal to the Department in response to this solicitation.
