These units are for use primarily on high-speed limited access facilities. Because of the use on these roadways they may be deployed further from the edge of a roadway than would happen on a city street or in a construction zone. Also, these signs may be placed in locations without any additional warning such as would be common in a construction area. They are to warn and inform motorists whose speeds are possibly exceeding speed limits as high as 70 mph. In order to gain the attention of these motorists and allow them to react in the safest way possible we desire to have as visible a message as is possible. A 24 inch display is 1/3 larger than an 18 inch display. It is for these reasons that we have required a 24 inch display as part of the specifications of this bid.
