## Safety Rules for Pedestrians

- ◆ Always walk on the shoulder of the road facing traffic.
- ◆ Look left and right before stepping off any curb to cross a street.
- ◆ Cross only at intersections or designated crosswalks.
- ◆ Cross with the green light or WALK signal.
- ◆ Wear light colored or reflective clothing.
- ◆ If you must walk on a street at night, use a flashlight.
- ◆ Carry some form of ID.



## Rules of the road for bicycles

- ◆ Ride with the flow of traffic.
- ◆ Obey all traffic laws.
- ◆ Yield to traffic when appropriate.
- ◆ Be predictable.
- ◆ Stay alert!



## Safety Rules for Bicyclists

- ◆ Wear a properly fitted bicycle helmet.
- ◆ Adjust your bicycle to fit your height.
- ◆ See and be seen.
- ◆ Control your bicycle.
- ◆ Watch for and avoid road hazards.
- ◆ Avoid riding at night.
- ◆ Look before turning.
- ◆ Watch for parked cars.
- ◆ Carry some form of ID.
- ◆ While riding between sunset and sunrise, lights (in front and rear of the bicycle) are required.
