

Driving Log Instructions

How much driving experience is required to get an operator's license?

- Parent or guardian certification that you have **at least 50 hours** of behind-the-wheel driving experience, of which 10 hours must be at night.
- Drivers with a Learner's license, may only drive during daylight hours during the first three months and until 10 p.m. thereafter, **always** with a licensed driver who is at least 21 years old and occupies the front passenger seat.

Recording behind-the-wheel practice sessions will help to better assess and analyze time spent behind the wheel.
