



INTERNATIONAL FUEL TAX AGREEMENT 2017 RENEWAL NOTICE

- All delinquent IFTA Tax Returns must be filed and any outstanding taxes and penalties must be paid before your 2017 licenses and decals can be issued. You may **not** process delinquent Tax Returns at the walk-in counter.
- Your Renewal application is processed when received if your 2016/3rd quarter Tax Return has been filed and any required payments have been made.
- You **must** include your Florida IRP account number on your IFTA renewal. If you do not have a Florida IRP account, you must have IFTA qualified motor vehicle(s) registered in Florida.
- Renewal applications and Tax Returns can be filed electronically or by mail at the address noted on the renewal.
- Do **not** display your 2017 IFTA decals until December 1, 2016.
- We **may** limit the number of IFTA decals issued on your account based on the number of IFTA qualified motor vehicles registered in your name in Florida. Additional documentation may be required to support the number of sets of decals on your renewal or subsequent decal orders.
- We will **not** renew your license if you have filed IFTA Tax Returns indicating 'No Operations' or 'Florida Miles Only' for 3 or more consecutive tax quarters.
- You are **required** to keep detailed records of mileage and individual fuel purchases to support the mileage and tax paid fuel purchases reported on your quarterly IFTA Tax Returns.

We encourage you to take advantage of the department's electronic filing system for commercial vehicles, which is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. To set up an e-file account, you must first be registered. Visit <http://www.flhsmv.gov/html/welcome.html> to obtain an application and mailing instructions.
