SUBJECT: Executive Order Number 18-150– Relief due to Subtropical Storm Alberto Terminated	

Overview:

The Governor’s Executive Order Number 18-150 declared a state of emergency exists in every county in the State of Florida due to the severity and magnitude of Subtropical Storm Alberto. With this Executive Order, the Governor offered relief for services to victims affected by this severe weather. The Governor has signed an order terminating this order.

Details:

Effective June 19, 2018, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will implement the termination of the following procedures:

- Residents of Florida may not be charged a delinquent fee for late renewal of driver licenses or registrations that resulted from office closures. Delinquent fees for renewal of driver licenses or registrations may also be waived for customers adversely affected by this severe weather in counties where office closures did not take place.
- Fees for replacement driver licenses and identification cards may be waived for any customer adversely affected by this severe weather in a way that caused the customer to lose their driver license or identification card. In these cases, offices will process a no-fee replacement and Tax Collector offices may waive the \$6.25 service fee by selecting “Tax Collector Issuance Error” on the no fee replacement reason screen.
- Fees for duplicate title certificates and duplicate registrations may be waived for any customer adversely affected by this severe weather in a way that caused the customer to lose their title or registration. All offices will have the ability to waive the fees in FRVIS.
