**SUBJECT: Insufficient Funds Transactions** 


## **Overview:**

The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) is aware that Tax Collector Offices need instruction on processing insufficient funds transactions to identify all the fees that need to be paid. When the transactions are processed incorrectly, the clerks do not collect the correct dollar amount in fees. The attached instructions and screenshots will provide the proper way to process insufficient fund transactions, identify what is owed, and collect the appropriate fees.



## **Inquiry On an Insufficient Funds Transaction**


From the Miscellaneous Menu, click Go To, then Titles and Registrations.



• Under the Inquiry Tab, choose Stops, then Insufficient Funds.




• The Insufficient Funds Transaction Inquiry form will open.




• If the citizen has the official letter with them, the Insufficient Fund Number (ISF number) is at the end of the letter and is labeled as ISF Reference Number. The ISF number is all the digits before the period. In this example, the ISF number is 1344.




• If the citizen does not have the official letter, use the **SEARCH BY CUSTOMER** button and enter the DL or FEID number, or Customer Name etc.




 Once the ISF is retrieved, please look at the PAYMENT AMOUNT and the REFUND AMOUNT. If a difference is listed, it means there are additional fees to collect.




• If you need to identify those fees that made up the **PAYMENT AMOUNT**, navigate to the **Miscellaneous Menu** and select **Inquiry.** Next, select **History**, then **Miscellaneous Revenue** in the sub menus.



 Enter the Transaction ID from the INSUFFFICIENT FUNDS TRANSACTION INQUIRY screen.



• It will display all fees associated with the **Transaction ID** in question.
