SUBJECT: Emergency Order 040822 (Pursuant to Executive Orders 22-54 and 22-55) Emergency Management – Northwest Florida Wildfires Until May 4, 2022.

Overview:

Pursuant to Executive Orders 22-54 and 22-55, Executive Director Terry Rhodes has provided the attached Emergency Order 040822 waiving fees for customers adversely affected by the wildfires in Bay, Calhoun, and Gulf counties.

Details:

The Emergency Order is effective immediately extending the fee waivers authorized in <u>DL22-009</u> and <u>RS/TL22-004 Emergency Order 030522</u>.

The order expires at midnight on May 4, 2022.

The Emergency Order waives the following fees for those customers affected by adverse weather conditions, including in counties where FLHSMV has closed offices, or any office of the county Tax Collector that acts on behalf of FLHSMV to process renewals has closed offices due to adverse weather conditions:

- Replacement driver license and identification cards
- Replacement fees for vehicle registrations and titles
- Replacement fees for vessel registrations and titles
- Replacement fees for disable parking permits
- Late/Delinquent fees for applicable transactions listed above.

When waiving fees, please add "EO 22-55" to the comments/remarks field when completing the transaction. Tax Collectors who contract with License Plate Agents, please ensure that they are aware of the Emergency Order.
