SUBJECT: Postage Fee Increase – July 10, 2022	

Overview:

Effective July 10, 2022, the U. S. Postal Service (USPS) will increase postage cost for letter-sized mail.

Details:

As a result of the USPS postage rate increase, FLHSMV will update the postage fees for issuance systems. This change will affect FRVIS, MyDMV Portal, MV mail-in Renewals and Virtual Office (VO).

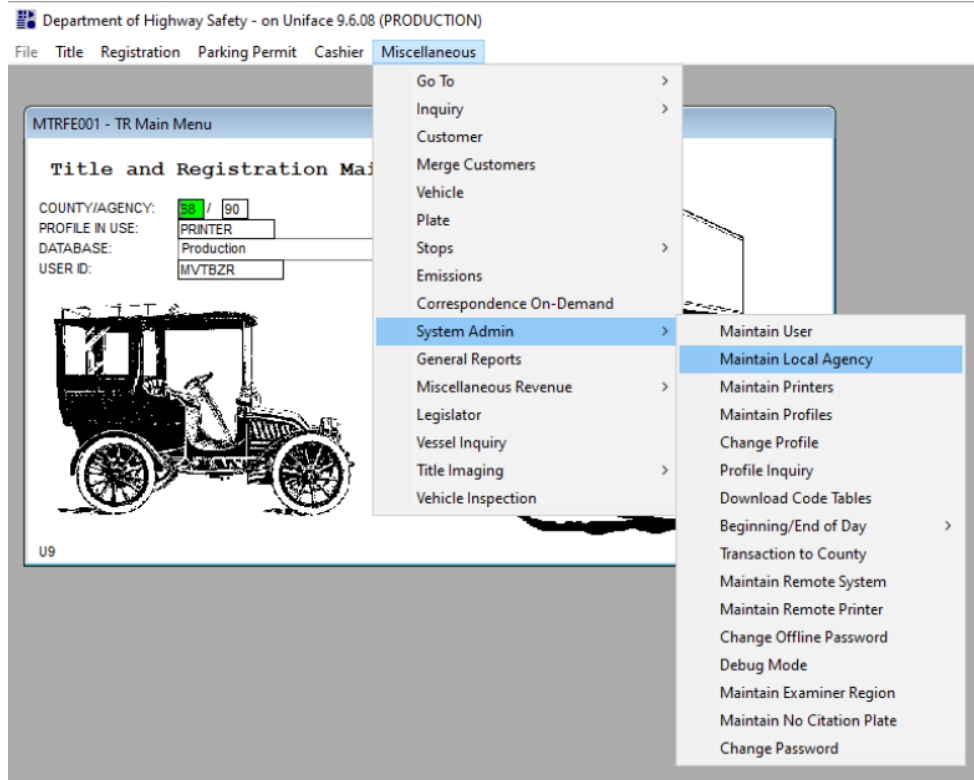
The updated service charge for mailing will be updated as follows:

MD	DECAL MAILING FEE	\$0.90	\$0.05

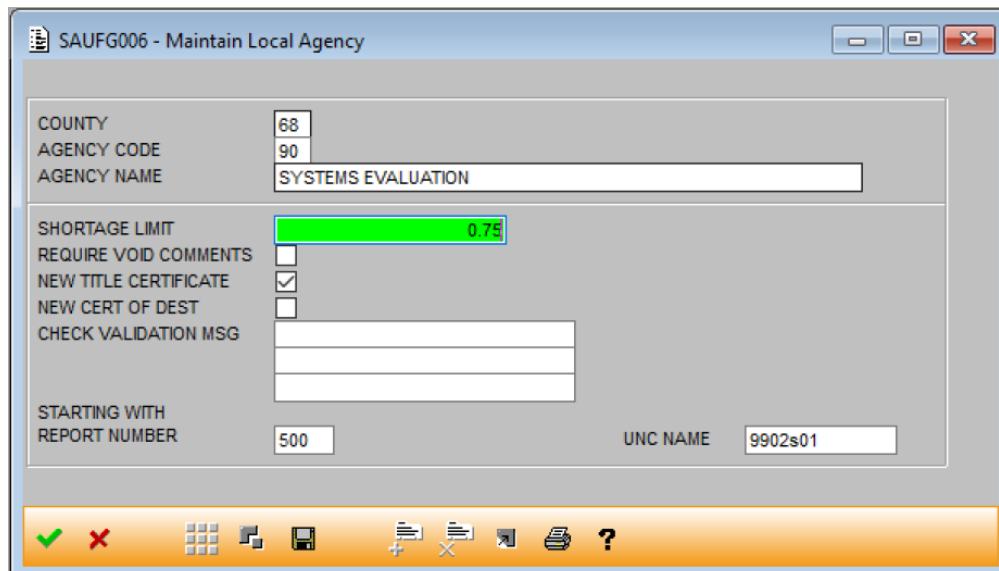
Effective July 10, 2022, transactions processed in FRVIS, MV mail-in renewals, VO/GoRenew and MyDMV Portal will charge the updated mail fee. At this time, the July, August and September 2022 motor vehicle registration renewal files have been released and have the current mail fee.

We encourage all tax collector offices to set their shortage limit to their desired amounts. Failure to reset the shortage limit could result in errors.
