| <b>SUBJECT: Transporter License Plates</b> |                                          |

**Overview:**

Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) and Dealer Services is sending this notification of change related to tax collectors and license plate agencies no longer processing applications/requests where an entity would have more than five transporter plates. This change will require requests that will result in more than five transporter plates to be processed through a FLHSMV Motorist Services regional office. Please see below.

**Details:**

1. For entity's whose request will result in more than five transporter plates, the tax collector or license plate agency will need to refer them to an FLHSMV Division of Motorist Services Regional Field Office.
2. When requesting additional plates where the request will result in more than five transporter plates the tax collector or license plate agency will need to refer them to a FLHSMV Division of Motorist Services Regional Field Office.
3. Tax Collector offices or license plate agency are authorized to replace up to five transporter plates with a police report case number. If more than five are requested, the entity must be referred to a FLHSMV Division of Motorist Services Regional Field Office.
