SUBJECT: Updates to TL-72 Ancient or Antique Motor Vehicles and

Antique Vessels

Overview:

Updates have been made to TL-72 Ancient or Antique Motor Vehicles and Antique Vessel to clarify documentation requirements.

Details:

The following updates have been made to the Certificate of Title Section:

When a customer presents a certificate of title for an ancient or antique motor vehicle or antique vessel in their name, or the title presented has been reassigned into their name the title will be processed as an Original Used Title (OUT) per Procedure TL-10 or as a Florida Title Transfer (TRT) per procedure TL-11.

If the Florida title is issued as original used for the ancient or antique motor vehicle, a VIN inspection is required and may be completed by the owner and one of the following:

- Military Police Officer or Law Enforcement Officer from any state
- Licensed Florida Dealer
- Notary Public commissioned by the State of Florida
- DMS Compliance Examiner/Inspector or DMS/Tax Collector employee or agent
- A sworn affidavit or HSMV 82042 Part A, signed by the purchaser and seller verifying the identification number shown on the motor vehicle.

A HIN inspection is not required for an antique vessel transaction where a certificate of title is presented as indicia of ownership.

The following updates have been made to the Vehicle Identification or Hull Identification Number Inspections Section:

When a customer present indicia of ownership that is other than a certificate of title for an ancient or antique motor vehicle or an antique vessel a VIN or HIN inspection is required. The VIN inspection must be obtained at the local Dealer Services Regional Office. The HIN inspection must be completed by a member of the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FFWCC).
