SUBJECT: Deauthorization of Kids Deserve Justice Specialty License Plate	

Overview:

The Kids Deserve Justice specialty license plate has been discontinued. Florida law requires the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) to discontinue the specialty license plate with the lowest number of valid registrations. As of January 1, 2023, the Kids Deserve Justice organization had 1,336 valid registrations.

Details:

On February 15, 2023, the Kids Deserve Justice specialty license plate will be discontinued. Please remove all inventory from your offices and PRIDE will remove them on future deliveries. The inventory codes are KDR, KDP, and KDA.

A vehicle owner or lessee issued a specialty license plate that has been discontinued may keep this discontinued specialty license plate for the remainder of the 10-year license plate replacement cycle. All other applicable registration fees will continue to be collected during the annual renewal period. They will no longer be charged the \$25 annual specialty license plate fee that FLHSMV distributes to Florida Bar Foundation, Inc. No original, replacement, or personalized license plate reservation transactions can be performed. If the customer chooses to switch to a different license plate, all applicable fees will be charged. Additionally, the gift certificate voucher for the Kids Deserve Justice specialty license plate is deauthorized and is no longer available to customers.
