SUBJECT: Voucher Requirement Met-Auburn University Specialty License Plate	

Overview:

The Auburn University specialty license plate has met the voucher requirement. Purchasing pre-sale vouchers is no longer required for this license plate to meet the requirements.

The initial order for license plates will be placed soon.

Details:

After the initial order of license plates is placed, we will change the Sales Status Code from **P-Authorized for Pre-Sale** to **D-De-Authorized**.

To ensure we provide an adequate supply of license plates the Sales Status Code will only change up until the date the license plates are shipped.

Once the license plates are shipped to the county tax collector offices the status will be changed to **A-Authorized for Sale**. The inventory codes for personalized and amateur radio license plates will also be available at that time. After the initial order is received, offices can place additional orders.

We do not have a delivery date yet, but we anticipate the plates will be shipped to the county tax collector offices within the next 4-5 months.

The license plate is NOT deauthorized, the code will only be changed temporarily to allow for manufacturing and shipping.
